STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED FOR 48 HOURS

Chelsea, August 10, 2024 – The Municipality of Chelsea declared a state of local emergency throughout its territory at 9:10 a.m. today after contacting the Government Operations Centre (GOC) to notify them of implementing the Emergency Measures Plan.

The torrential rains damaged several roads, and our team worked hard to restore traffic on the following roads last night:

- Chemin de la Montagne
- Chemin Meech
- Chemin Juniper

The following main roads are still closed to traffic. Our teams are on site this morning to assess the work required to restore these roads as quickly as possible.

- Chemin Hollow Glen
- Chemin Fleury

To ensure the safety of its residents, the Public Works team also inspects the road network to identify secondary roads, culverts, driveways and private roads on which certain residences may be hemmed in.
