



PUBLIC NOTICE

To those persons eligible to vote, having the right to be registered on the Municipality's referendum list for the following by-law:

- By-law No. 1143-19 – Borrowing by-law establishing expenditures and a loan required for the reconstruction of chemin du Lac-Meech (P8 Parking to chemin Dunlop)

Notice is given that:

1. Following the January 14, 2020, adoption of by-law number 1143-19 decreeing expenditures and a loan for the purposes mentioned above, persons that are eligible to vote, having a right to be registered on the Municipality's referendum list and wishing that the by-law becomes subject to a referendum, can exercise their right by registering their name, address, and status, accompanied by their signature, in the register intended for this purpose.
2. For a referendum to be held, the number of requests needed for this by-law is 537.
3. If the number of requests needed is not reached, by-law number 1143-19 will be considered approved by those persons eligible to vote.
4. The above-mentioned by-law can be consulted from January 21st to 27th, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and January 28th 2020, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Town Hall, 100 Old Chelsea Road, Chelsea, Quebec.
5. The register will be available on January 28th, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Town Hall, 100 Old Chelsea Road, Chelsea, Quebec.
6. The results of the registration process will be announced on January 28th, 2020, at 7:01 p.m. at Town Hall, 100 Old Chelsea Road, Chelsea, Quebec.
7. **CONDITIONS:** To be considered as eligible to vote with a right to be registered on the Municipality's referendum list, the following conditions must be met:

Is a qualified voter:

- 1) a person that is not disqualified from voting and who, on January 14, 2020, meets the following conditions:
 - must be domiciled on the Municipality's territory;
 - must be domiciled in Quebec for at least 6 months; or
- 2) a person that has been, for at least 12 months, the sole owner of an immovable or the sole occupant of a place of business, not disqualified from voting and that, on January 14, 2020, meets the following conditions:
 - must be the owner of a property or the sole occupant of a place of business located on the Municipality's territory for at least 12 months; or
- 3) an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a place of business, not disqualified from voting and that, on January 14, 2020, meets the following conditions:

- must be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a place of business located on the Municipality's territory for at least 12 months;
- must be designated, by way of a document signed by the majority of the owners, or co-owners since at least 12 months, as the person selected to sign the register in their name and to be registered on the referendum list, if necessary. This power of attorney must have been written up prior to or during the signing of the register.

A natural person must be of full age and a Canadian citizen and must not be under curatorship.

To be a legal person, you must:

- have been designated by the members, administrators or employees, by resolution, and be, on January 14, 2020, of full age and a Canadian citizen, and not under curatorship nor disqualified from voting by law;
- have produced before or during the signing of the register, a resolution designating the authorized person to sign the register and, if necessary, the one to be registered on the referendum list.

Other than in the case of a person designated as representing a legal person, no one can be considered as a person eligible to vote in more than one capacity, according to Section 531 or the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*.
