It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the planted tree(s) respect the following distances (see article 7.3.4 of the zoning by-law):

- 2.5 metres from a street light.
- 1.5 metres from building drainage pipes
- 1.5 metres from electrical or telephones cables.
- 1.5 metres from any pole carrying electrical wires, while ensuring that Hydro-Québec's recommended distances are respected.
- 1.5 metres from buried electrical equipment.
- 2.5 metres from fire hydrants.

The following species are prohibited for this application:

- Ash trees (*Fraxinus sp.*)
- Willow (*Salix sp.*)
- Poplars (*Populus sp.*)
- Norway maples (*Acer platanoides*)
- Boxelder maples (*Acer negundo*)
- Silver maples (*Acer saccharinum*)
- Shubert plum (*Prunus virginiana "Shubert"*)
- American elm (*Ulmus americana*)
- Siberian elm (*Ulmus pumila*)
- Black locust (*Robinia pseudoacacia*)
- Cedars (*Thuja sp.*)
- All ornamental and/or stem-grafted trees
