## OFFICIAL LOGO UNVEILED FOR CHELSEA'S 150<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

**Chelsea, November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024** – The Municipality of Chelsea unveils the visual identity for its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations at a press conference on November 27, 2024, at the Town Hall Library (100 Chemin d'Old Chelsea). Attendees, including journalists, municipal employees, members of the 150<sup>th</sup> Organizing Committee, and local elected officials, gather for an exclusive preview.

Chelsea celebrates its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2025. To do so, the Recreation and Communications departments, in partnership with the 150<sup>th</sup> Organizing Committee, made up of residents, local entrepreneurs and community organizations, have collaborated to develop an identity that honours the municipality's storied past and reflects its present and future. The design intertwines modern and nostalgic elements, highlighting the importance of sports, the environment and social cohesion within the Chelsea community.

The official unveiling allows guests to discover the new municipal logo and the slogan that will be used in 2025. In addition, a preview of next year's celebrations is presented.
